She was kind and clear with her expectations. • Excellent professor. • She was very responsive and provided great encouragement and feedback! • I would consider finding a new textbook and cutting down the assignments to focus more on the hands-on elements that are needed to be successful and manage education technology projects. The first assignment template for example had recommendations for almost 7-10 paragraphs per subsection, similar to what I wrote for a dissertation summative. And then the sudden shift in the end to making a video with camera angles in 3,000 different directions was frustrating. What are the key points of the course? Its only 8 weeks, its impossible to do this much work and really digest what we are learning. The instructional design course had a lot of work in it as well, but we focused on developing one major project, and that is my recommendation for this course to shift to a case study model. I almost literally quit school over this class, and I already have a doctorate. Its definitely needs to be revised into more realistic chunks of work and increased engagement on the discussion boards. The course is only 8 weeks, and that should be taken into consideration when designing the curriculum. I literally have never been this frustrated taking a class, and as someone who has done this for 17+ years and supported teachers, I can honestly say if it were not for the awesome professor, I would have dropped out of this program. In fact, I've never completed a survey except once. This class needs some major revision and focus on the key skills the students need to learn for developing and managing education projects. I learned absolutely nothing from the textbook with the exception of some tidbits on project based learning.
